## McCARTHY FLIES HIGH ...

It was a standout weekend for Reef McCarthy in Round 1 of the Victorian Formula Vee Championship at Sandown Motor Raceway, a perfect weekend netting three wins from as many starts putting the young gun in good stead as he builds towards his debut in the Super3 category at the Repco Mount Panorama 500.

Defending Victorian champion Jake Rowe took the first accolade of the weekend, securing pole position with a time of 1m 27.15s on his seventh lap of the session, putting him just 0.101s clear of McCarthy. Ashley Clifford enjoyed an outstanding session to line up P3, alongside Heath Collinson making it an all JRD Row 2.

Despite getting the initial jump over McCarthy off the line, Rowe came under fire heading into Turn 1, surrendering P1 to McCarthy who had tucked into the draft and immediately put it to good use. A rare Safety Car made an appearance, however, after the #23 Akurra Motorsport Jacer of Lucas Khawam speared into the wall on approach to Turn 9.

The field had just three flying laps remaining when the Safety Car pulled into the pits, McCarthy smartly holding the

field once Green flag conditions resumed.

Collinson was within reach initially, however he couldn't match the leading duo, Sandown not Collinson's favorite track in the State Series. Despite a wild ride over the Turn 6 kerb, Rowe couldn't overhaul McCarthy, eventually settling for P2 behind his younger rival. Collinson meanwhile was the winner of a JRD battle with teammate Clifford for P3 and P4 respectively.

Sunday morning's Race 2 had Rowe making a swift getaway to lead into Turn 1, with Clifford also making a stellar start to be P2 into Turn 2. Collinson took advantage of a slow McCarthy to sneak onto the podium in the opening lap, however McCarthy was mega along the back straight, passing both JRD cars for P2 in one calculated move.

Despite a hefty margin to Rowe at the head of the field, aided by some setup guidance from JRD McCarthy was able to reduce the margin, and gave the defending champion a challenging task holding onto P1.

Brett Burden meanwhile was lucky to get away with a wild trip over the kerb and grass at Turn 9, running wide onto the recently established run off area.

McCarthy made his way back passed Rowe on Lap 2, but as they showed in the opening race of the weekend, they easily had Collinson covered for outright pace to make it a two-way battle for the win. Rowe had the lead at the start of the final lap, but it was all part of McCarthy's plan. The #61 Beacham prepared car made its move on the back straight securing the lead and taking the chequered, leaving Rowe in his shadow.

Nick Kerr and Clifford meanwhile enjoyed a solid battle for P4, Clifford eventually edging ahead of his rival.

The 10-lap finale was a showdown between McCarthy and Rowe, with little splitting the two for pace and ambition as they battled for the race and round win. However, McCarthy was once again too strong for Rowe, successfully and strategically defeating Rowe to make it three race wins, and with it, the Round 1 victory.

Rowe capped his weekend off in P2, while Collinson featured in the lead battle early in the race, until his pace saw him fall within reach of Burden who enjoyed a strong race ahead of Kerr. Clifford came home P6, just ahead of Shane Purvis.
